Accessibility, Pedestrian Accomodations	Is there access to crosswalks from the north side of New Gorham Road heading east to Main Street or WCD? Currently, one cannot cross New Gorham Rd to crosswalks.	No sidewalk exists or is proposed to be built on the Northern side of New Gorham Road within the immediate vicinity of the William Clarke Drive intersection, therefore no crosswalk is being provided to cross either New Gorham Road or WCD from this corner. A signalized crosswalk is being provided on the Southerly side of New Gorham Road crossing WCD heading East towards Main Street.

Bike and Pedestrian Accomodations, Traffic, Road/Design	Thank you so much for this. The congestion in Westbrook is miserable, though not as heavy at present because of the pandemic. My concerns/feedback: 1) No right turn onto Main Street will be problematic. I suggest a semi-circle connector if all possible. 2) Timing - with major construction happening at the Mechanic St intersection (Vertical Harvest & parking garage) , I encourage public communication of alternative routes of travel if the timeline overlaps at all. 3) "Sharrow" lane paint and signage to indicate bicycles use full lanes since I see no indication of bike lanes. 4) It looks ready to roll.
